### *FIRST* Scholarship

#### Scholarship Description

In support of the *FIRST* mission, and in recognition of the achievements of *FIRST* participants, Northwestern University is pleased to offer one need-based scholarship of up to \$5,000/year to a high school senior who has participated on a *FIRST* team during high school and has been admitted to Northwestern University. This scholarship may be utilized toward any undergraduate degree program at Northwestern University and is renewable up to a total of \$20,000 over four years, contingent upon maintaining satisfactory academic progress and continuing to demonstrate financial need. The recipient may be eligible for additional need-based financial aid from Northwestern University.

#### Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be a senior in high school
- Have participated at least one full season during high school on a *FIRST* Robotics Competition (FRC) team or a *FIRST* Tech Challenge (FTC) team
- Apply and be admitted to Northwestern University as a full time undergraduate student in a degree program. (However, you do not need to have already been admitted at the time you apply for this scholarship.)
- Demonstrate financial need by following the normal procedure for applying for financial aid from Northwestern University (see <http://ug-finaid.northwestern.edu/topics/prospective/overview.html>)

The e-mail stating your interest in this scholarship should include your name, permanent address, *FIRST* team number, *FIRST* program (FRC or FTC), and your intended major. The deadline by which to send this e-mail is **February 15<sup>th</sup>**.
