## *FIRST* Scholarship

### **Scholarship Description**

In support of the *FIRST* mission, Baker University is offering a \$1000 scholarship to seniors who have participated on a *FIRST* team during their school career and enroll at Baker. The scholarship is renewable up to a total of \$4000 over four years, contingent upon maintaining good academic standing. Each recipient must meet the regular academic requirements for admission to Baker and will receive consideration for the many other types of financial aid Baker offers.

### **Eligibility**

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be a senior in high school
- Have participated on a *FIRST* Robotics Competition (FRC) team, a *FIRST* Tech Challenge (FTC) team or a *FIRST* Lego League.
- Apply and be admitted to Baker University as a full time student. (However, you do not need to have already been admitted at the time you apply for this scholarship.)

### **Scholarship Application Package Contents**

To apply for the Baker University *FIRST* Scholarship, complete the application package, including:
